

The posters

In some countries the schools have more resources in other countries less and there they will be happy if you bring posters with you. The pictures you can download from the homepage and if you can glue them on big pieces of cardboard they will have a long life and can be used in many different classes. Make them at home (it's a lot easier than doing in your country of visit) and bring them in your suitcase! Very often the posters have a front and a back. The pdf-files are often in A4 and you print them in A3 to get the right size. Some of the pictures are in color but never mind that, print them all in black and white.


Front: With this you practise pronunciation
The size you see on the photos is two pieces of A3 put together.




Back: The students talk about the persons. **Sam is tall** etc.




Front: With this you practise pronunciation.
A student can also point to the different persons and talk about his/her family. **My father's name is ___** etc.



Back: **Who is this? It is the grandfather** etc.
A student can also point to the different persons and talk about his/her family. **My father's name is ___** etc. (more difficult now without the name of the family members.
When students know the numbers up to 100:
How old is the grandfather? He is ___



Front: Practise pronunciation



Back: Practise pronunciation of activities and questions.
 If the students are learning the activities use only the first person. **I eat ice cream** etc. You can come back later to work with 3rd person -s.
 You can point at a picture and ask **What do you do? I play basketball.** etc.
 A student can stand next to the poster and point and talk: **I eat ice cream, I play basketball** etc.

Poster used for practise daily activities with rhythm. Size: only A3
 See the film called Every day. The back can later be used to learn how to read the activities (after the students have learned them by heart).
